  - ▶ A good sermon has

    - ▶ Dynamic
  - ▶ Read through series of points

- ## CONCLUSION AND APPEAL
- ▶ Restates the main points
  - ▶ Challenges or appeals to the hearer to act on what they have heard and/or felt the spirit saying to them
  - ▶ Commit to memory
