### 103 DAYS TO GO

The 2019 ‘HeartheCall’ Trans-Pacific Union Mission Camporee is less than 3 months away. Pathfinder Clubs throughout the Trans-Pacific Union are working very hard to raise funds for this exciting memorial event. You will be camping with Pathfinders from the other countries in the Trans Pacific Union Mission. This is your chance to enjoy the opportunity of a lifetime. If you would like to be part of this program, the fee of \$150 FJD closes on the 30th September. Please complete your Individual Application Form now and be sure to complete the Medical Information, Emergency Contact and Consent and Release sections also. Once you have completed your Individual Application Form, give it to your Pathfinder Director and you are on your way to becoming a part of the 3rd Trans Pacific Union Mission Pathfinder Camporee.

### DAY VISITORS

The Trans Pacific Union Camporee, like all other major youth events, will be a **CLOSED EVENT**. In other words, only those who have legally registered and paid together with camporee staff will be permitted ‘on site’ during the Camporee. This is not only for security reasons but also, so that the facilities you pay for are available for your use. It will not be possible for people to live ‘off site’ and visit the Camporee during the day. Our Security Officers will ensure that this rule is adhered to for the smooth-running of the event and your safety.

### OPENING & CLOSING CEREMONY

The Trans Pacific Union HeartheCall Pathfinder Camporee will commence with the Opening Ceremony at 8:00am on Tuesday December 17, 2019. It will conclude after the closing ceremony on Saturday night, December 21, 2019. Departure from the Campground will commence on Sunday morning the 22nd December, 2019 at 7:00am. HeartheCall Camporee is a closed event, however, parents and friends are most welcome to attend **ONLY** the Opening Ceremony and Parade at 8:00am on Tuesday the 17th of December. It is expected these guests will depart after the Opening Ceremony.

#### Please Note:

Clubs are requested not to leave the grounds until after 7:00am on Sunday morning the 22nd December, 2019. All clubs must leave the grounds by 2:00pm. Please coordinate your travel times accordingly.

#### Registration Times and Camping SetUp

Clubs will be given registration times between 8:00am and 2:00pm on Monday, 16th December, 2019. This gives ample time for each club to register and pitch their tent and also settle into their allocated sub camps before the opening ceremony at 8:00am on Tuesday, 17th December 2019.

#### Please Note:

Sub camp Directors and Chaplains are required to meet with all the Club Directors in their sub camps in the afternoon, 16th of December, 2019 at 3pm for sub camp orientation, planning and organising of sub camps flag raising, clubs singing and World Changers Bible Training during the morning devotional period.

### Camporee Stamp

We have a special HeartheCall Camporee stamp to commemorate this awesome event. Please bring your Pathfinder Passport to add this stamp to your collection. If you need to purchase a Pathfinder Passport, please contact your local ABC store or Mission Youth Department.

### Uniform

Pathfinders need to be in full dress uniform at the Opening Ceremony on Tuesday the 17th of December and again on Sabbath morning the 21st of December. On all other occasions your field uniform will be appropriate.

### Summer Heat Shaded Areas

All clubs need to be prepared to bring sufficient shade cover for their eating/meeting areas. You will receive a Water Bottle during registration for you to refill your drinking water as hydration is very important. Water will be sold at the camporee store. Sunscreen will be vital. Sunburn is hot and uncomfortable and can do much damage to one's skin. It is imperative that you bring enough supply of sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses as required.

### Supervision

Pathfinders in their unit are to be with their Counsellors at all times. This means meals, parades, evening program, and other activities. Please outline to your Counsellors that they have the very important work of caring for each of their unit members' social, physical and spiritual well-being during this Camporee. It is essential that Pathfinders are supervised while on site at all times. PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR COUNSELLORS ARE AWARE OF THE IMPORTANCE OF THEIR DUTY OF CARE WHILE AT CAMPOREE.

Each team will be allowed a maximum of 10 minutes to complete their marching skills display on THURSDAY AFTERNOON, 19th December, 2019.

While encouraging creativity in the marching display, the organisers would remind team leaders that marching that featured aerobics, sensual movements and dancing CANNOT be accepted as part of the display.
