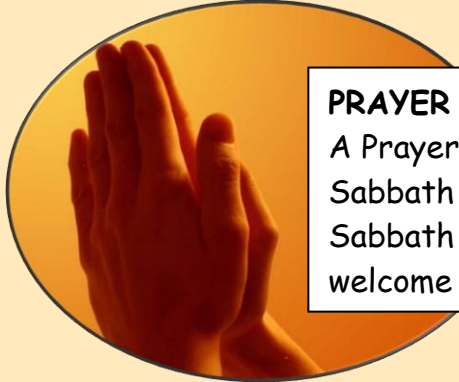

Jesse Owens – Gold Medal Hero



James Cleveland "Jesse" Owens grew up in a Christian family in the early 1900s, facing racial discrimination and health issues. Owens excelled in school sports and later continued to shine at Ohio State University. In 1935, despite an injury, he earned a place in the 1936 Berlin Olympics. Owens won four gold medals, defying Nazi propaganda and becoming a global icon. He also formed an unlikely friendship with German athlete Luz Long, whose sportsmanship helped Owens secure the gold medal, highlighting the human spirit's capacity for connection and compassion.
