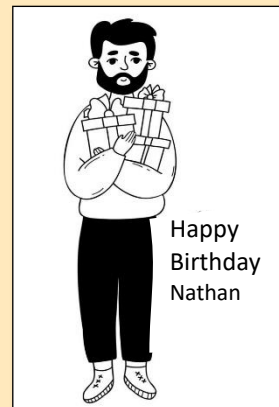
PRAYER GROUP

David Pudney's Avondale Jazz Ensemble:

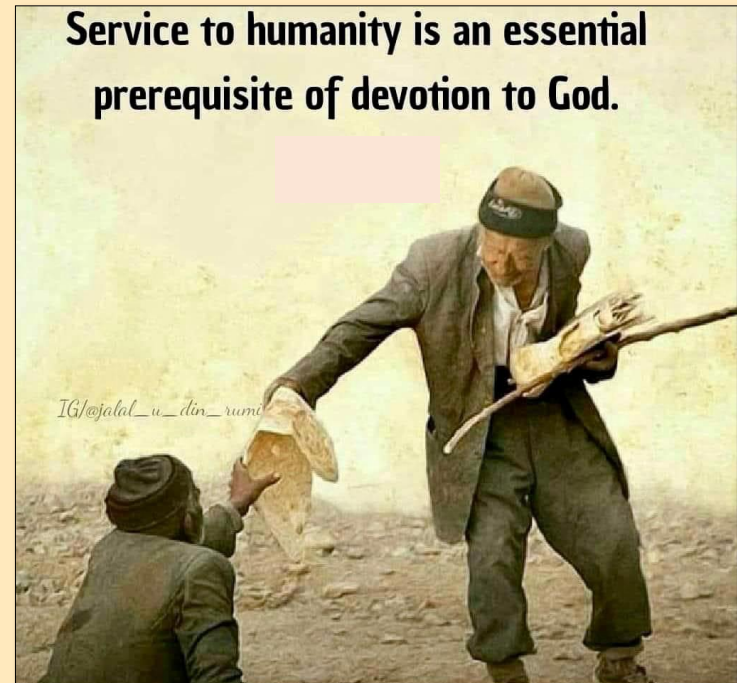
10 Flavours Thursday, 26th September

Help a refugee family find a home. Can you help a refugee family from Venezuela find a home? They are looking for a \$450-\$550 per week rental in the local area. Because Alexandra uses a wheelchair, they need an accessible entrance and two to three bedrooms. The family are Christians who worship in a local Seventh-day Adventist Church. They have received a strong recommendation from their current landlord, who praises their cleanliness, helpfulness, and ability to pay their bills. He describes them as "exemplary tenants."
