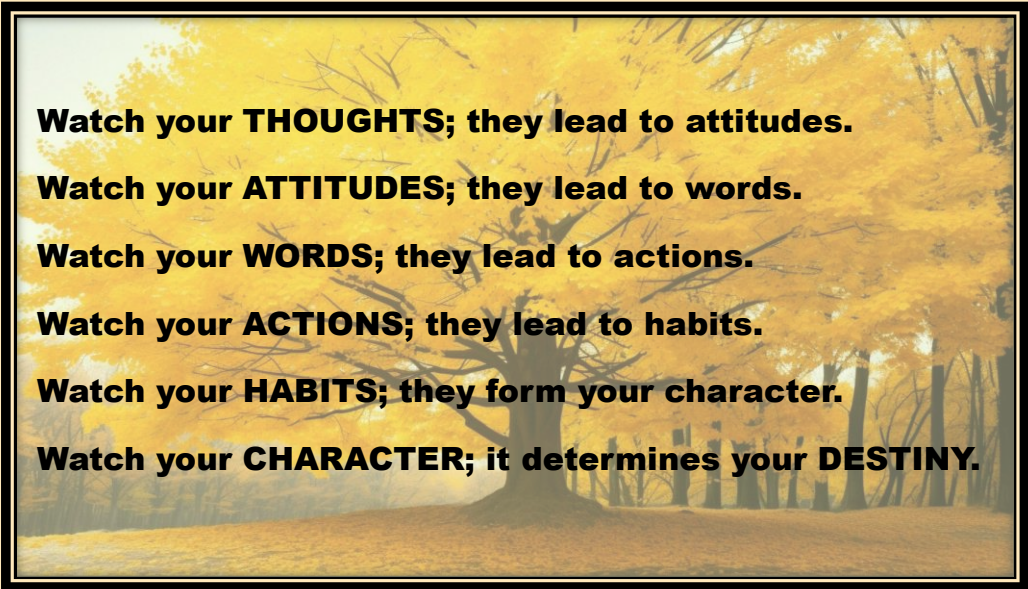

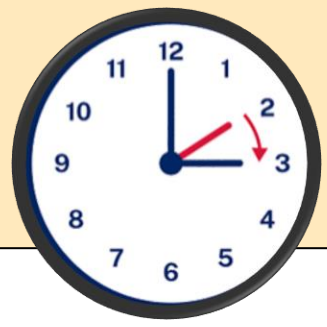


PRAYER GROUP

GUEST SPEAKER: Dr Simon Pedzisi

Simon has worked in the healthcare industry for almost 20 years in clinical, operational, and leadership roles including Director of Clinical and Director of Care Services, Clinical Associate, and National Lead for the UK's National Gold Standard Framework for palliative care. Simon has qualifications in Adult Nursing, an MSc in Leadership and Management, and further completed a Doctorate qualification from the UK where his research project was designing and implementing health care interventions to improve the standards in nursing and elderly care. Subsequently he introduced the first Care Home Education Centre in the UK and co-founded the Network of Care Home Researchers in London.

He was a visiting Lecturer at several universities in the UK where he presented social care matters around leadership, best practices, mentorship, and employability for health and social care programs. Over the years he has presented at different national and international events around research in best practices and models of care that incorporate person-centred and relationship-centred care in Australia and overseas.

Simon currently works as Head of Dementia Care at Opal Health Care. He is also the Dean of Research at Opal Health Care Academy leading several research projects in collaboration with universities in Australia in subjects such as dementia, re-enablement, wellbeing, polypharmacy, and brain health.

Simon has been a Director of Adventist Senior Living since May 2024.
