

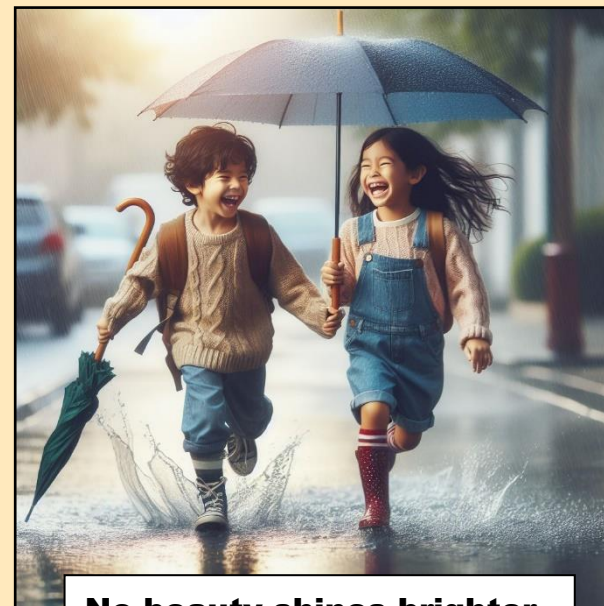

SABBATH AFTERNOON PROGRAM

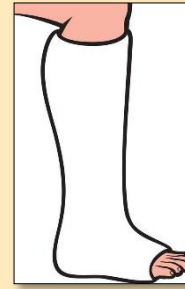
