It's important to remember that Anzac Day was yesterday. It's a celebrated day, and a public holiday, to commemorate the Australian and New Zealand soldiers who served and died in all wars, conflicts, and peacekeeping operations. It is particularly significant as it marks the first major military action of World War I, the landing at Gallipoli on April 25, 1915. This day is a time for remembrance, reflection, and honouring the sacrifices made by those who served. During World War I, red poppies were among the first plants to grow on the battlefields, bringing new life to the devastated landscape, which is why they are the symbol of remembrance. The red poppy's vivid color is often associated with the blood of fallen soldiers

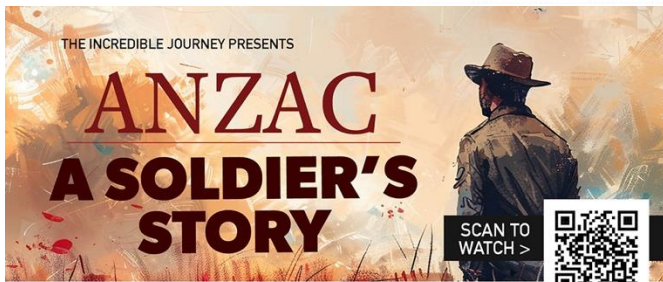
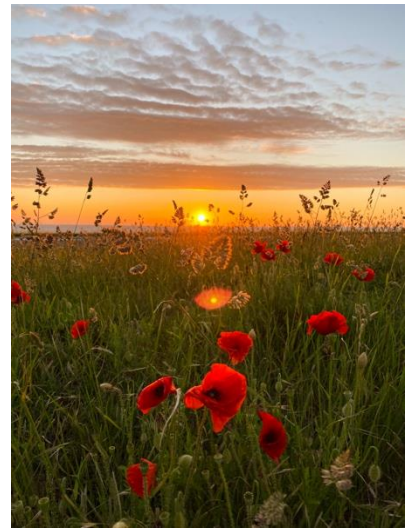
