Samuel Marsden
New Zealand's Gamechanger

Born to a humble blacksmith in Yorkshire, England, Samuel Marsden became a key figure in early colonial Australia. A chaplain, magistrate, farmer, and wool industry pioneer, his impact reached far beyond the church. In the early 1800s, he extended his influence to New Zealand, establishing the first mission station at the invitation of a Māori chief. There, he introduced Christianity, new farming methods, and worked to curb the musket trade and trafficking of tattooed heads. Discover how Marsden's bold vision helped shape the histories of both Australia and New Zealand.
