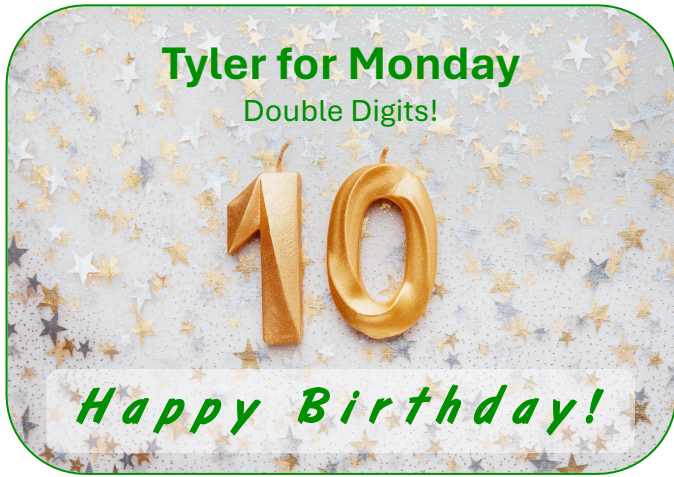
Of course, everyone wants to see families coping better and not relying on food support, but in reality things have not changed in Australia. Our role is to be there to support families until their situation can improve.
