#### **The Gipsy Moth and Aviation's Golden Age**

In the early 20th century, England and Australia produced some of the world's greatest pioneering aviators. Among them were Amy Johnson, the first woman to fly solo from England to Australia, and C. W. A. Scott, whose daring flights captured global attention. Their stories are marked by courage, determination, and astonishing leaps of faith. Nearly a century after Scott's record flight, the very de Havilland Gipsy Moth he flew was painstakingly restored and returned to one of his original landing sites in Brisbane. ### *3ABN Now*

While at the GC Session in St Louis in July 2025, John and Rosemary had the opportunity to interview **Tim Maddocks** from SALT Ministries in Cambodia. Tim spoke about the ministry he and his wife, Wendy, began there almost 30 years ago on land outside Siem Reap. Beginning with a bare parcel of land, then building a small wooden hut for themselves and two small sons, they started a small clinic for locals and a lay training centre for SDA Cambodians to learn how to spread the Gospel. Now they have 9,000 sq feet of buildings, including a boarding school, orphanage, Butterfly Garden tourist development, staff housing, etc. Plus, we discuss deliverance ministry, which they found to be very needed in that society, including some stories for illustration. Tim has also written a powerful book on this topic, with many examples and applications to western society. Listen to his stories of God's guidance and how God used them to grow His mission in Cambodia. You will be glad you tuned in. 3ABN Australia's 1 hour interview program, 3ABN Now, can be viewed on 3ABN International every week on Sundays at 7:00pm, repeated Tues., 7:00pm and Wed., 9:00am.
