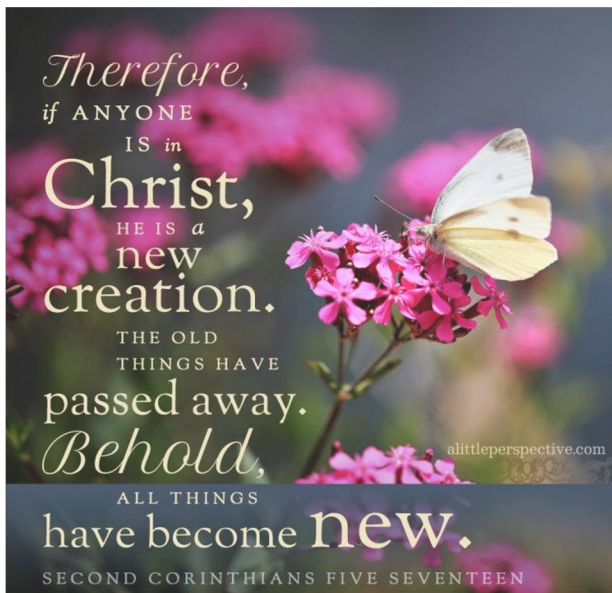

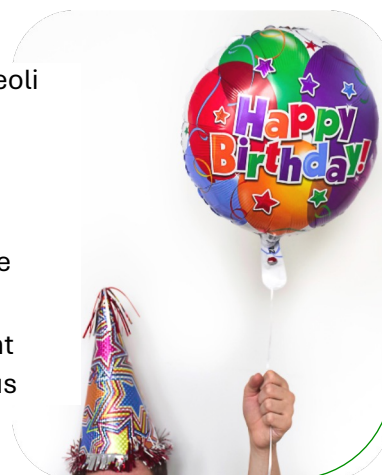

The Incredible Journey

Outback Camels and Big Lizzie

Since the 1880s, Broken Hill has been a prominent mining town and a crucial trading centre, attracting workers and becoming a base for inland camel trains. At the height of the camel train era, it hosted two of Australia's largest cameleer camps. One of the town's workers, Frank Bottrill, was a young man who arrived in the late 1880s. Troubled by the struggles of the overburdened camels, he designed and built an innovative traction engine with dreadnought wheels called Big Lizzie. In this episode we'll explore the history of Broken Hill, its camel trains, and Bottrill's remarkable machine.
