## The Incredible Journey

Nicholas Winton –

Save One Life, Save the World

Even now, new Holocaust stories continue to emerge, revealing a level of evil almost beyond comprehension. For the Nazis, simply being Jewish meant a death sentence—children included. Historians estimate 1.5 million mostly Jewish children were killed. How can we begin to grasp that? Yet amidst this horror, remarkable courage still shone through. One such hero was Nicholas Winton, a young British stockbroker who, in 1939, set out to save Jewish children as war loomed. He rescued 669 by bringing them to Britain. His story reminds us that even in humanity’s darkest moments, courage and compassion can still light the way.
