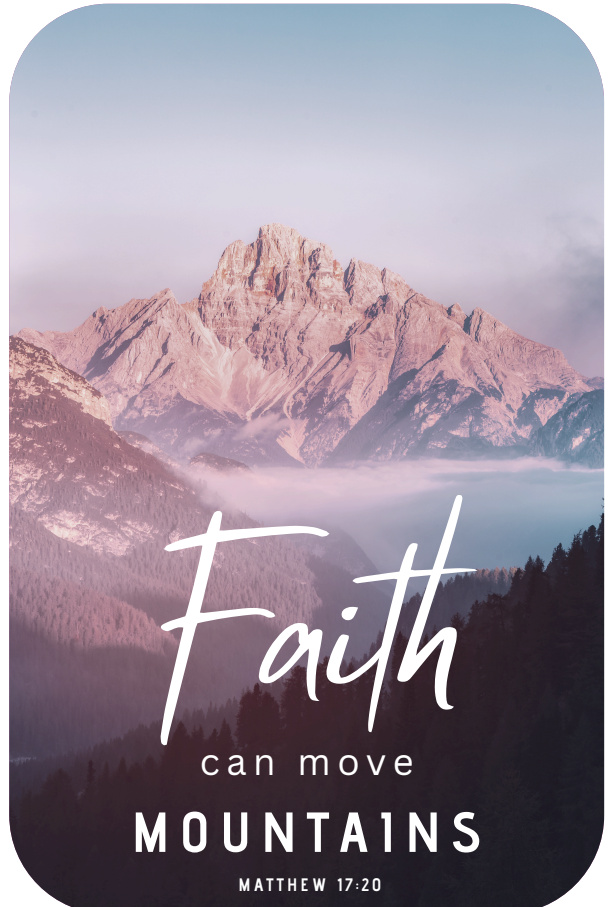

When the Bridge Fell – The Tangiwai Train Disaster

On Christmas Eve 1953, tragedy struck New Zealand when the Wellington to Auckland night express plunged into the Whangaehu River after a volcanic mudflow swept away the Tangiwai Rail Bridge. Lives were lost, and the nation was stunned. It was one of New Zealand's darkest days — the eighth-deadliest rail disaster in the world at the time. With a small population, nearly everyone knew someone affected. That it happened on Christmas Eve only deepened the sorrow.
