CREATION MAGAZINE: Reasonable to believe in something you cannot see?

Theoretical physicist and Nobellist Steven Weinberg apparently said, “The invisible and the non-existent look very much alike.” His quip was intended to take aim at God. Nevertheless, even atheists acknowledge the existence of many realities that cannot be directly observed—such as black holes, magnetism, gravitation, and wind. However, atheists agree that they are known from their effects.

We could say the same about God and His creative acts, and the Resurrection of Jesus. We cannot see such things today, but they have impacted the world in ways that are visible and measurable.

Among the reasons for rejecting materialism are the compelling arguments that support the existence of an immaterial Creator of the universe. These include the design of living things, the fine-tuning of the universe for life, and the evidence that it has a finite age, among other arguments. These features of reality are best explained by the biblical teaching that God is the Creator.

The Bible tells us there are certain unseen realities that are even more important than things visible to us. Christians must seek the things that are unseen and lasting. (See 2 Corinthians 4:16–18; 1 Timothy 4:7–8).

These unseen realities are of much greater priority than the physical. Jesus said in Matthew 6:25, “Do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or drink, nor what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing?” We are to “seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you” (Matthew 6:33).
