ADRA LOGAN - Assistant Manager

ADRA Australia is seeking a part-time Assistant Manager to join our team at ADRA Logan Community Centre. You will be part of an experienced and fun team that is focused on serving the community.

This role encompasses two areas of responsibility:

The Assistant Manager works alongside the Centre Manager to ensure that all community services align with ADRA's mission and strategic direction, responding effectively to the current and emerging needs of individuals and families in the Logan region. The role includes overseeing the recruitment, induction and ongoing management of volunteers across the Logan Community Centre and Op Shop.

In addition, the Assistant Manager is responsible for supervising the Emergency Relief program and ensuring year compliance with Work Health and Safety (WHS) and Food Safety policies throughout all centre operations. Services offered by the ADRA Logan Community Centre include (but not limited to) the provision of food (food parcels as well as a weekly soup kitchen), clothing, furniture, emergency relief and assistance to those in need and also those suffering the effects of relocation because of domestic violence. Services also include an Op Shop as well as running nationally recognised accredited courses and community training courses.

You will be responsible for living out our values of Connected, Courageous and Compassionate in all interactions with the team, volunteers and trainees. You are a people person and thrive in communicating with others, while being able to work efficiently, accurately, professionally and in a timely manner to provide a best-in-class assistance to the Centre Manager as well as to the Centre as a whole.

The successful applicant must have the legal right to live and work in Australia at the time of application.
